1. Who is eligible?

Freemasonry Cares offers guidance on the help available to anyone who has both:

A A Masonic connection

This includes:

- All current and former Freemasons under the United Grand Lodge of England
- Dependants of a Freemason, former Freemason or deceased Freemason: wives, widows, children and partners
- In some cases, non-dependant relatives who are clearly linked to a Freemason, former Freemason or a deceased Freemason: sisters, mothers **and**

B A real need

- This includes financial, healthcare or family-related support which the person concerned cannot easily meet from their own income or savings. It also covers certain other specific needs, for example moving into a care home.

2. What help do we offer?

Financial:

- Household expenses and goods
- Help to arrange home repairs and improvements
- Funeral costs
- Education support
- Emergency costs, arising from illness, death or redundancy

Healthcare:

- Operations
- Dental treatment
- Mobility equipment and home adaptations
- Hospital treatment
- Medication costs
- Care advice

- Sheltered accommodation
- Nursing, residential and dementia care

Family:

- Children's maintenance and education costs
- Care homes and sheltered accommodation
- Respite care
- Care advice
- Support for children with talent in music, sport or the performing arts
