

BROTHER MOVING TO A NEW LOCALITY

Particularly in this modern, mobile world, Brethren move, often with their work, to other parts of the country. They frequently wish to re-establish their Masonry in their new location, and so we provide a form by means of which the Masonic Authorities in his new area can be made aware of his presence, and offer help with finding a new Masonic home. The form is intended primarily for Brethren moving within England and Wales or to Scotland and Ireland but arrangements can be made for the form to be transmitted, via our own Grand Lodge, to other countries. All these arrangements must be made through our own Province of West Lancashire.

1. It must only be completed by or with the full and willing co-operation of the Brother concerned. His Lodge Secretary must sign the form to confirm this.
2. It **MUST** be sent to our Province: not direct to the Brother's new Province. We will make the necessary introductions and he will hear direct from his new Province once he gets there.
3. The Brother is under no obligation to join a new Lodge in his new location. This system is designed simply to make a smooth transition for him to new Masonic territory, should he wish it.
