CANDIDATES FOR EXALTATION (See also note regarding candidates from Foreign Constitutions)

A candidate must have been a Master Mason for at least four weeks before he can be Exalted.

Every candidate either for Exaltation/Joining who is or has been a member of a Lodge/Chapter under the English Constitution must, before election, submit his Grand Lodge/Grand Chapter Certificate to the Scribe E of the Chapter. An Unattached Craft Mason who is in Good Standing may become a Royal Arch Mason.

The candidate must also produce certificates from every Lodge (if an Exaltee) or Chapter (if a Joiner) of which he is or has been a member, recording his membership and indicating his standing in that Lodge or Chapter.

An elected candidate must be Exalted or take-up his Joining Membership within a year of his election, otherwise the election is void.

No more than two candidates can be Exalted on the same day without dispensation from the Province.
