CANDIDATES FOR JOINING WHO ARE NOT YET MASTER MASONS

Secretaries must see the Grand Lodge Certificate of a brother seeking to join his lodge *before a ballot is held.*

If the brother in question is not yet a Master Mason, the Secretary must instead see a Certificate of the First or the Second Degree, as appropriate.

The Secretary should advise (and indeed assist) the candidate to apply to the Provincial Office for help in obtaining this certificate. The candidate himself will also need to produce a 'clearance' certificate from every lodge(s) of which he is or has been a member.

Just as with Master Masons, if the candidate is from another Masonic jurisdiction, then before he does <u>anything</u>, the Secretary must apply to Grand Lodge (via the Provincial Office by e-mail), to ascertain the standing of the jurisdiction <u>and the lodge</u> from which the candidate comes. *This applies equally to Scotland and Ireland*, just as to jurisdictions further afield.
