MISBEHAVIOUR IN LODGE

If a Brother behaves in Lodge in such a manner as to disturb the harmony of the Lodge, he should be formally admonished by the Master.

If he persists, and a majority of members <u>present</u> so decide, he can be formally censured (which would be recorded on the minutes) or excluded from the remainder of the meeting.

He can also be reported to higher Masonic Authority.

A Lodge has the ultimate power, under Rule 181, to exclude a Brother permanently from the Lodge. (see 'Deaths, Resignations and Change in Membership – exclusion/cessation')
