## REMOVING OFFICERS

Should the Master be dissatisfied with the conduct of any of his Officers he may put the cause of complaint before a regular meeting of the Lodge.

The Officer concerned must be informed at least seven days before that meeting of the particulars of the complaint.

If a majority of members present at that meeting agree that the complaint is well-founded, the Master then has the power to displace that Officer and appoint another. In the case of the displacement of the Treasurer, the Master will cause an election to be called at the next regular meeting.

An elected TYLER can be summarily removed from office for reasons deemed sufficient by a majority of members present at a regular meeting of the Lodge.
