Procedure to be adopted when the Grand Superintendent visits a Private Chapter Centenary Meeting with the Provincial Team

The Provincial Team would consist of the following officers. MEGS, 2nd & 3rd Provincial Grand Principals, DeptGS, Local Assistant to the Provincial Grand Principals, PrGSE, PrGSN, PrGDC, PrGSwdB, PrDGDC, PrGStdBs and PrGJani-tor. Together with other Acting Officers who are present.

AT LEAST TEN DAYS BEFORE THE MEETING

A copy of the Chapter Summons for the meeting should be sent to your principal guest and a copy to the PrDC and all the members of the Provincial Team attending.

FOUR DAYS BEFORE THE MEETING - (or when requested)

Advise the PrDC of the full names and ranks of <u>ALL</u> the Grand Officers and the Senior West Lancashire Provincial Grand Officer who will be attending and any other information which you think should be made known to the PrDC, <u>particularly the name of any Provincial Grand Officers holding acting rank.</u>

2 HOURS BEFORE THE MEETING

The following Companions to report to the PrDC

- 1. The Provincial Team
- 2. Acting Officers attending
- 3. The Three Principals
- 4. The Chapter DC, ADC, Scribe Nehemiah & Janitor

THE MEETING

- 1. Open the Chapter at stated time.
- 2. Carry out ALL domestic matters.
- 3. PrDC will then form a procession of Grand and Provincial Grand Officers.
- 4. Janitor will announce that "the Provincial (Deputy) Grand Director of Ceremonies seeks admission".
- 5. On being admitted the PrDC will announce, "The Grand Superintendent stands with-out and demands admission".

- 6. Z replies, "We will be honoured to receive him".
- 7. PrDC makes an announcement.
- 8. The Grand Superintendent will be greeted by the ME 'Z' and offer him the Sceptre the MEGS accepts it and takes 'Z' Chair.
- 9. The 2_{nd} and 3_{rd} Provincial Grand Principals accept 'H' & 'J' Sceptres and take their chairs.
- 10. The MEGS is saluted by the PrGSwdB who then moves to his seat followed by the PrGStdBs all remain standing.
- 11. All are then seated with the exception of the Provincial Team.
- 12. The MEGS addresses the Convocation firstly by introducing the Provincial Team.
- 13. MEGS, 2_{nd} & 3_{rd} Provincial Grand Principals stand and give knocks and MEGS says; "By virtue of the power vested in me I declare this Special Convocation of Provincial Grand Chapter open" (MEGS, 2_{nd} & 3_{rd} PrGP's then sit)
- 14. MEGS then addresses the Companions on the purpose of the meeting and invites the Provincial Grand Scribe Ezra to read the Centenary Charter.
- 15. The Centenary Charter is then read by the Provincial Grand Scribe Ezra.
- 16. The MEGS then presents the Centenary Charter to the ME'Z'.
- 17. The MEGS invests the ME'Z' with his Centenary Jewel. (If applicable)
- 18. The Provincial Grand Director of Ceremonies announces that the Centenary Jewels can be worn by the Companions of the Chapter. (If applicable)
- 19. An Oration is then given by the Clerk in Holy Orders.
- 20. Preparation for the closure of Provincial Grand Chapter. (MEGS & PrGDC)
- 21. MEGS then invites the Clerk in Holy Orders to give a prayer of Re-Dedication.
- 22. MEGS, 2nd & 3rd Provincial Grand Principals stand and give knocks and MEGS says; "By virtue of the power vested in me I close this Special Convocation of Provincial Grand Chapter" (MEGS, 2nd & 3rd PrGP,s then sit)
- 23. One verse of the National Anthem.
- 24. The MEGS then invites the Chapter Principals to re-occupy their chairs.
- 25. A short history of the Chapter is then given.
- 26. The ME 'Z' thanks the MEGS and his Team for their attendance.
- 27. Presentation of cheque for Masonic Charities to the MEGS by the ME 'Z' (If applica-ble)
- 28. Charity Collection if Chapter practice.
- 29. After the 1st Rising the PrDC will form the recession.
- 30. The Chapter will thereafter be under the direction of the Chapter DC.

TOAST No 5 – Toast to the Chapter Proposed by the Local Assistant to the Provincial Grand Principals- Response by the Chapter ME'Z'

TOAST No 5 – Toast to the Visitors Proposed by Chapter nominee- Response by PrGSN

TOAST No 5 – Toast to Absent Companions Proposed formally by Chapter ME'Z' with no response
