The Lodge was consecrated at the Masonic Hall, North Hill Street, Liverpool 8 on 10th July 1871 in the name of The De Grey & Ripon Lodge No.1356 on the register of the United Grand Lodge of England.

At this our 150th anniversary, we remember with pride and honour the founders and all the Brethren who have made our Lodge one to be proud of.

May the present members continue, in the finest traditions of Freemasonry, to build on the foundations so truly laid on the 10^{th} July 1871.

In the year 1882, the original title of the Lodge was changed to Toxteth, authority being granted as under.

PROVINCE OF WESTERN DIVISION OF THE COUNTY OF LANCASTER

To the Worshipful Master and Brethren of the De Grey & Ripon Lodge No. 1356, meeting at Liverpool in the said Province, You having at Regular Meeting held on 8th February 1882, decided unanimously to alter the name of the Lodge to the,

TOXTETH LODGE

and having appealed for my approval of the same, I do hereby make known my approval and authorise and empower you, the Worshipful Master, to make the said alteration for doing thereof. This shall be your authority.

Given at London, 24th March A.D. 1882

Signed Lathom D.G.M.

When the lodge was originally formed it met on a Wednesday this being half day closing as the early membership was made up from shopkeepers.

Over the lodge history it has had several homes, starting in Northhill Street in the Toxteth area, moving to Eberle Street and then to the Masonic Hall in Hope Street, whilst there the lodge suffered some historical losses in the fire in the 1960's.

In September 1980 the lodge moved to the Racquets Club in Parliament Street, but unfortunately that building and everything in it was totally lost by the fire in the summer of 1981, after the summer break we found a new temporary home in the Bradford Hotel Tithebarn Street, which again during our two-year stay suffered a fire. We then moved into Woolton Hall in September 1983 until it's closure at the end of the masonic season in May 2006. Our home since then is our current residence at the Woolton Golf Club.


From its formation in 1871 Toxteth Lodge never repeated a Worshipfull Master, it wasn't until 2014 that for the first time a member of the lodge went back into the chair for the second time, this honour was bestowed on W/Bro Eric Binks who was then followed by W/Bro Arthur Bartley, W/Bro Phillip Birch and W/Bro Stephen Lawler. Then in 2018 we were able to install Bro Stephen Robinson as a new master, the lodge committee then decided our new masters could stay for 2 years, we were then hit by the pandemic, therefore Bro Stephen Robinson completed an unparalleled three years.

Today for this our 150th anniversary, Bro Ian Kenneth Folksman has been proudly installed as Worshipful Master as his Grandfather W/Bro Fredrick Folksman was installed as the Worshipful Master for the lodge Centenary.

Throughout its history Toxteth Lodge has found many members from within their families, Fathers & Sons, Sons-in-Law, Grandsons, Brothers and Cousins, also introducing close friends, who have then introduced freemasonry into their families. Currently there are still several members with close family links, such as Father & Son, Brothers, Cousins & In-Laws and hopefully, long may this continue.

PROVINCIAL GRAND LODGE

THE PROVINCE OF WEST LANCASHIRE

Freemasonry has deep roots in Lancashire. The earliest mention of a ceremony is in the diary of Elias Ashhole who records his initiation in the Order of Warrington on 16th October 1646. The county, which was at first one Province, remained so until 17th April 1826, when after two years of wrangling and the suspension of the then Provincial Grand Master, it was divided into East and West. The Western Division then embraced all the Lodges on the West side of the Great North Road (A6) extending from Stockport in Cheshire, through Manchester, Bolton, Preston and Lancaster to Burton in the County of Westmorland including Preston and Lancaster, but excluding Bolton. This boundary remains to this day despite the changes in County boundaries resulting in some of the present Lodges being in Merseyside, Cheshire, Greater Manchester or Cumbria. The change of name from Lancashire Western Division to West Lancashire to place in 1960.

In 1826, when the Western Division was created, there were 25 Lodges with 467 members. 100 years later there were 261 Lodges with 24,872 members. Now 195 years on there are 345 Lodges with approximately 8,000 members. It will be seen that although the number of Lodges has increased steadily, the average number of members in each Lodge has been reducing in line with modern thought that with smaller Lodges comes scope for more brethren to actively participate in Lodge affairs.

Because of the size and considerable area of the Province, an organisation was set up in 1910 to assist the Provincial Grand Master's chairmanship of a festival for the R.M.I.G. This involved arranging the Lodges in the Province into a series of groups, 22 at the time. The Group system proved so successful it was decided that for the better organisation of the province, it would be continued and it has proved of immense value to the Province administration ever since. The Group officials give generously of their time and effort for the furtherance of Freemasonry in this the second largest Province. There are now 19 Groups all with their Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary and each taking it's turn to host and provide Stewards so essential for a successful Provincial Grand Lodge Meeting.

Provincial Grand Lodge meets twice a year, ie; Blackpool in May and Preston in October, these venues being large enough and central for all West Lancashire Masons to attend.

Provincial Officers and all those who hold the rank of Master Mason and above are entitled to attend.

Proceedings are carried out by the Right Worshipful Provincial Grand Master and his Officers.
